Please write at least 60 words, and no more than 400 words on each of the following essay questions. Return your answers with this application.
1) Describe your past travel experience – when, where, why, with whom? Please include if you've had experience traveling internationally, in a group, and traveling on a budget.
2) Describe a challenge you've had while traveling and how you resolved it.
3) Why do you want to go to Ghana?
4) What expectations do you have for a trip to Ghana? Include positive and negative expectations (hopes, fears, personal strengths or weaknesses).
5) What does cultural humility mean to you? How do you anticipate handling situations where you are faced with customs and cultures different than your own?

Note: To participate in the trip you must be in good academic standing, have documentation of personal health insurance, a tetanus shot within the past ten years (also available through NUNM) and a current passport.

If you are selected, you will need to attend the mandatory pre-trip orientation and to enroll in the NUNM course that will be offered on the trip:

- *GSGH 835E – Ghana Global Health Experience (6 credits)*
- *The course fee is \$2,300 – this will come out of your financial aid*
