

Portland's National College of Natural Medicine receives \$200,000 for new research facility

The Meyer Memorial Trust has **given a grant of \$198,000** to Portland's **National College of Natural Medicine** to support a new research facility for **integrative medicine**.

The **naturopathic medical school** will formally open its Helfgott Research Institute and Community Education Center on Oct. 5, hosting a research lab, distance-learning classroom, offices and an instructional kitchen one-half mile north of the college's Lair Hill campus. The renovation of the 8,390-square-foot facility cost approximately \$1.5 million.

The Meyer Memorial Trust was created in 1982 by the estate of the late Fred G. Meyer, founder of the Fred Meyer chain. A private Portland-based foundation, it now has no connection with the chain.
