- Master of Science in Nutrition (MScN)





of participants with a clinical component in their degree currently use their NUNM degree in clinical practice.




76%

Which of the following sectors best describes your occupation(s)?






Which of the following best describes your practice setting?


What is the size of your practice (including yourself)?


Please select the categories that best describe your current occupation(s):




In what state do you currently practice?





Are you networked with other NUNM alumni, professionally or personally?






