Building Access & Parking

- ▶ NUNM now operates from three buildings: the **Woolworth Building** (1621 SW 1st Avenue, Portland, OR 97201), the **NUNM Clinic**, and the **Helfgott Research Institute**.
- ▶ NUNM Security is located on the 1st floor lobby of the **Woolworth Building**, behind the front check-in desk.
- ▶ Parking passes and access badges can be picked up **Monday-Friday, 8:00 AM-3:00 PM** at the Security desk.
- ▶ New students receive an **access card during Orientation Week**, enabling access to all NUNM buildings.

When do I Call 911?

When a crime is being committed or has just been committed in your presence.



Any emergency medical incident.



After information has been relayed to first responders please call security ASAP.

- Security can help investigate as well as provide assistance to first responders.

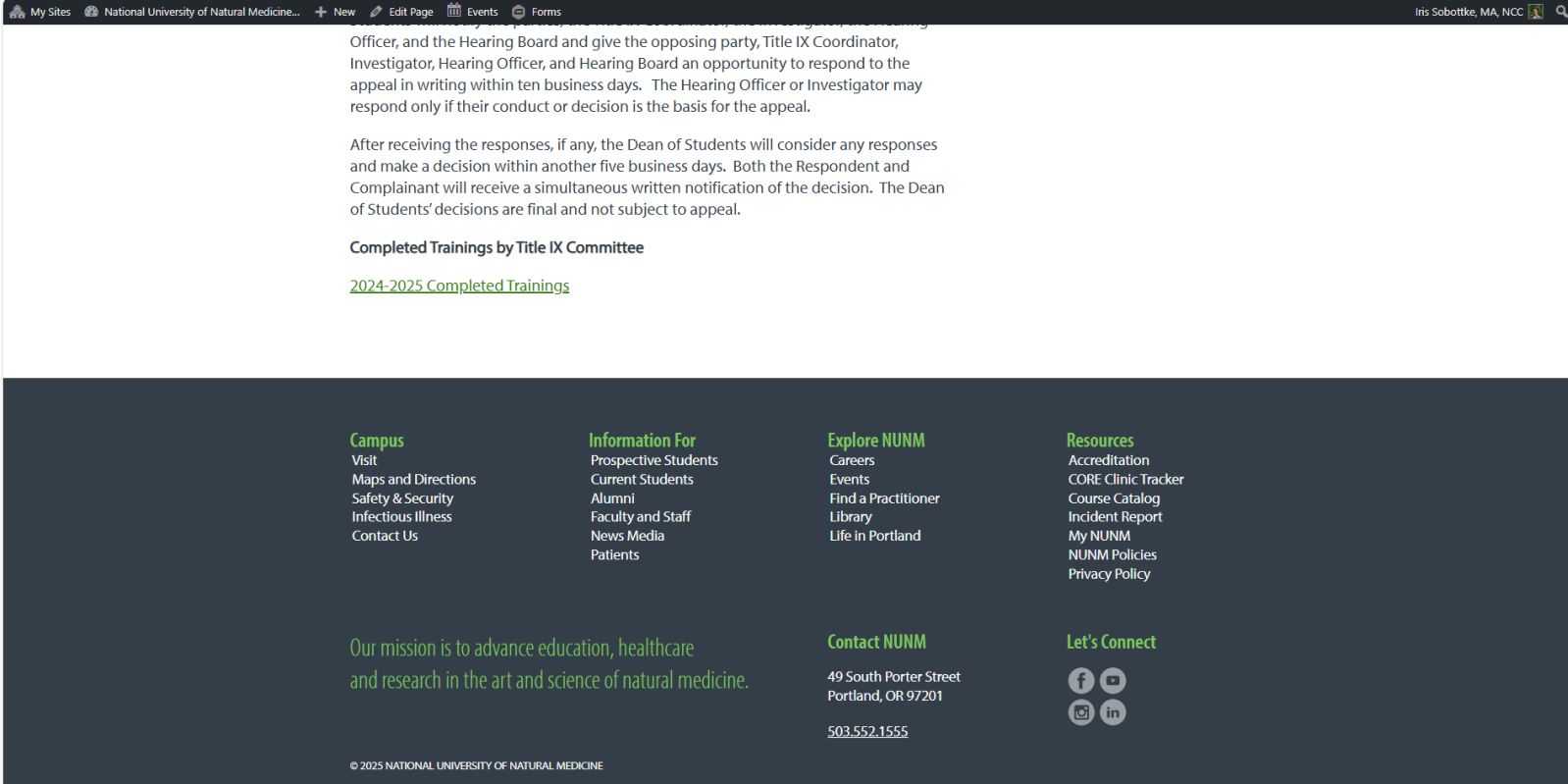
When do I call NUNM Security?

Officer, and the Hearing Board and give the opposing party, Title IX Coordinator, Investigator, Hearing Officer, and Hearing Board an opportunity to respond to the appeal in writing within ten business days. The Hearing Officer or Investigator may respond only if their conduct or decision is the basis for the appeal.

After receiving the responses, if any, the Dean of Students will consider any responses and make a decision within another five business days. Both the Respondent and Complainant will receive a simultaneous written notification of the decision. The Dean of Students' decisions are final and not subject to appeal.

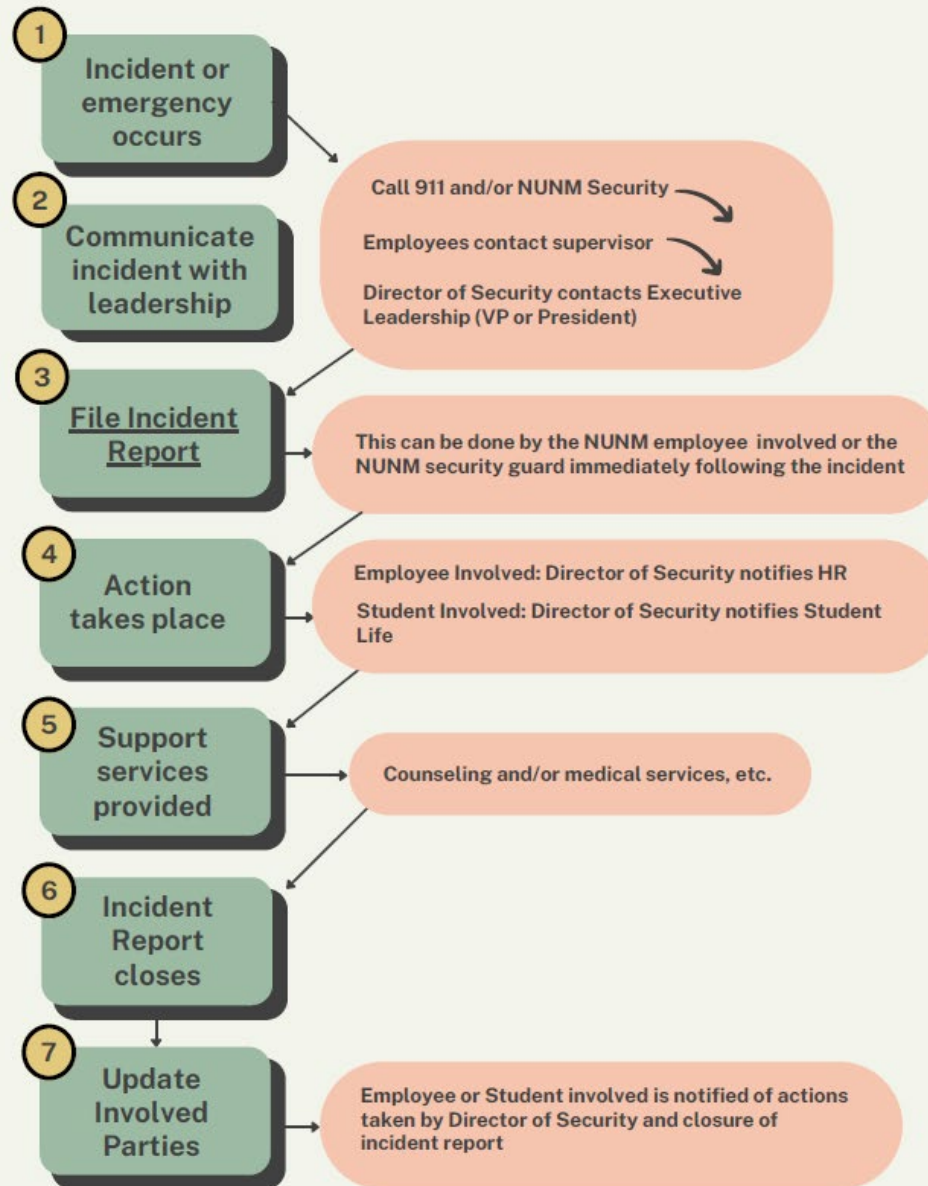

Things you can also report online

Students of concern or in crisis

- (CARE Team)
- Reach out students to provide them with assistance and resources.

Needle sticks and Bodily fluid exposure

- Always contact CMO right away! You may be asked to file a report online as well.

Accidents/Injuries/Severe Illness

- Contact Security right away. Title IX Report



OSHA Resources

OSHA manual is located behind the front desk area at the Health Center.

SDS sheets/manuals are located in the Woolworth Building-Library; Clinic-Reception; Helfgott-Reception

You can contact the officer on duty to request the manual or SDS sheets.

NUNM Safety Committee meets monthly. Contact COO for any questions.

- Safety Concerns can be directed to the Chief of Security.

Drug and Alcohol Policy

- ▶ Comprehensive information available in the student and employee handbook and on Policy Tech
- ▶ Drug or alcohol use, sale, transfer, or inebriation is prohibited on campus and at sponsored events.
- ▶ Students believed to be under the influence can be asked to undergo a rapid urinary drug screen follow by a confirmation blood test.
- ▶ There is an extensive exemption policy which allows limited alcohol consumption on campus. Contact Student Life or COO for more info.

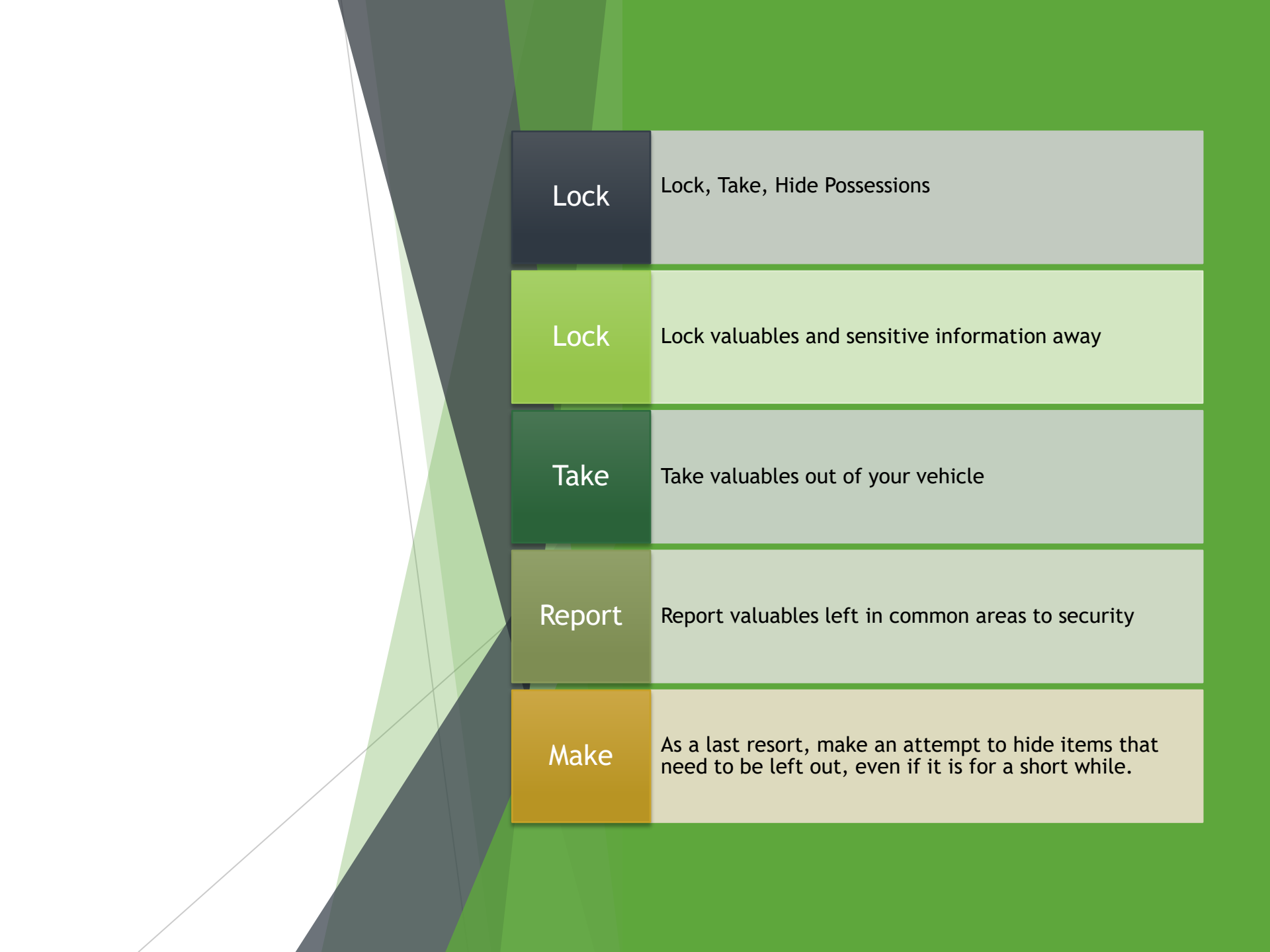

What to Watch For

- ▶ Doesn't Look Right
 - ▶ Suspicious people/vehicles/unattended belongings
 - ▶ Open or unlocked doors
 - ▶ Potential crimes of opportunity
 - ▶ Non-NUNM students or staff
 - ▶ Abnormal behavior that is alarming/disturbing

Remember, do not investigate suspicious activity, report it to security.

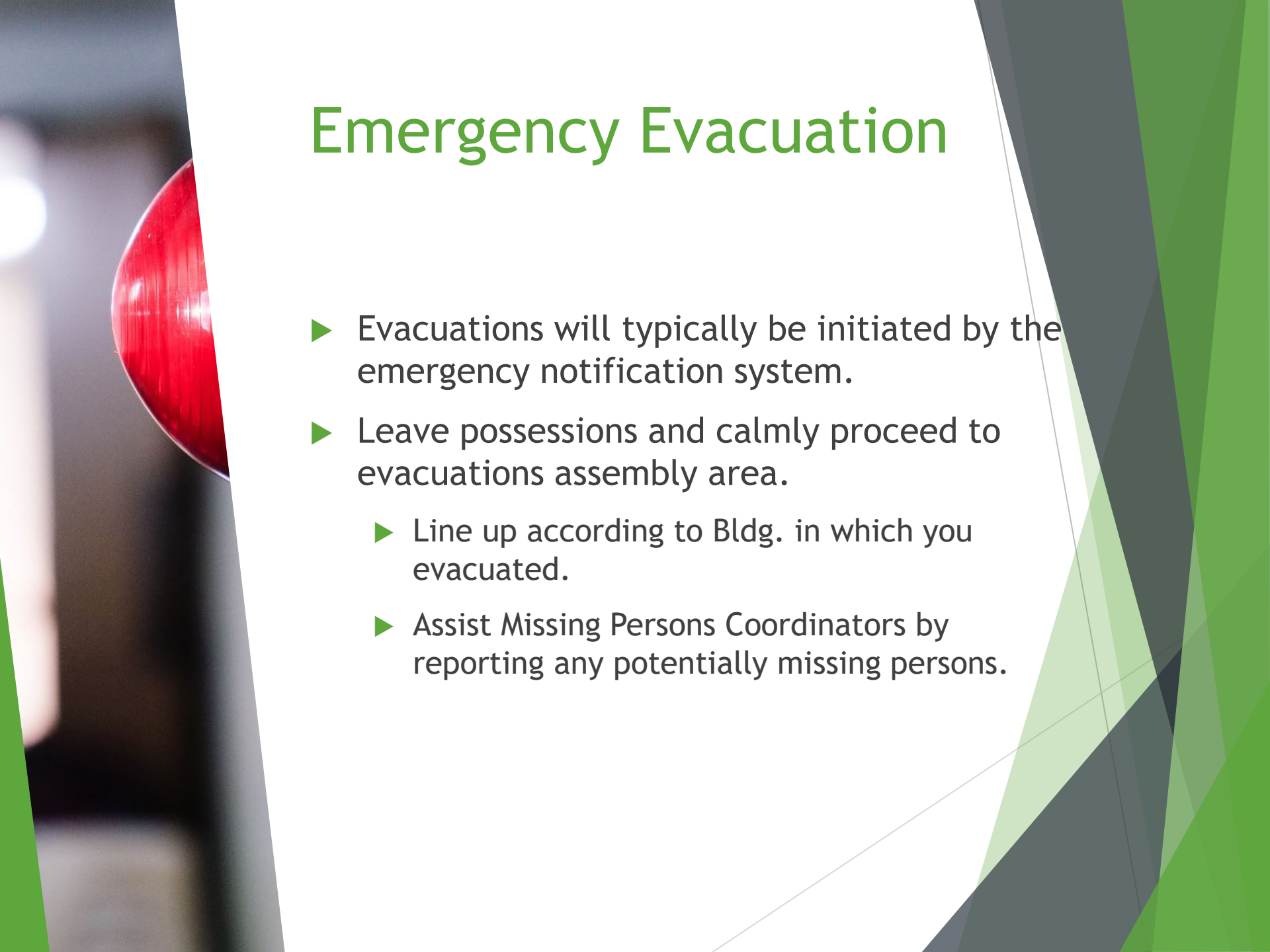

Our Duty to Warn/Notify

- ▶ The Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security and Campus Crime Statistics Act.
- ▶ Security must track all crimes reported to NUNM and evaluate when to notify the community of possible threats or trends in a timely manner.
- ▶ Report any known crimes ASAP.
- ▶ Call 911 first if the crime is actively occurring.



Emergency Evacuation

- ▶ Evacuations will typically be initiated by the emergency notification system.
- ▶ Leave possessions and calmly proceed to evacuations assembly area.
 - ▶ Line up according to Bldg. in which you evacuated.
 - ▶ Assist Missing Persons Coordinators by reporting any potentially missing persons.

Earthquakes



- ▶ Earthquake:
 - ▶ Stay calm and take cover away from large objects and windows
 - ▶ Proceed to Evacuation Assembly Area after shaking stops.
 - ▶ Do not pull fire alarm unless a fire is present.



Active Shooter/s

- ▶ Lockdown, Lock all doors and windows and remain quiet.
 - ▶ Turn off lights and barricade doors if possible.
- ▶ If you can not lockdown then Run/Hide/Fight
 - ▶ Leave possessions behind and evacuate
 - ▶ Do not attempt to flee in vehicle
 - ▶ If confronted by an assailant attempt to fight as viciously as possible. Use improvised weapons such as fire extinguishers.
- ▶ If safe to do so, evacuation to the Helfgott Bldg.
- ▶ Call 911 once you are at a safe distance
- ▶ Notifications via FinalSite Connect system will be sent to community members.
- ▶ Do not return to campus until instructed
